Getting to know the people of Haiti was a memorable experience. While we were there we worked at 3 different medical clinics. Two of those days were spent at St Martin and the other 2 were spent at mobile clinics in 2 other villages. We worked with Dr Mary Ange, who really has a passion for her people. We saw people from a

few months old to 95 years old. Some of the people had walked a long way to come to the clinic. There were many who were suffering from nutritional and stomach problems, Many complained of fever and decreased appetite.
